

RESOLUTION No. 15-219

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE NEVADA CITY HIGHWAY SIDEWALK EXTENSION PROJECT NO. 229622

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works proposes to design and construct 2,600 feet of sidewalk and pedestrian path along Nevada City Highway starting at the existing sidewalk at Banner Lava Cap overcrossing and extending to the existing sidewalk at Skewes Lane and Glenwood Rd in Grass Valley; and

WHEREAS, State Exchange and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds are available for the project; and

WHEREAS, under Section 15301(c) of the Public Resource Code, Class I projects are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of the Nevada County Department of Public Works to file a Notice of Exemption with the Nevada County Clerk's Office for the Nevada City Highway Sidewalk Extension Project.
