SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of a renewal contract with Crisis Intervention Services (Sierra Community House) for the provision of Latino Outreach Services, Family Support and Parenting Classes, and Behavioral Health Stigma Reduction in the Eastern County Region as a component of the County's Behavioral Health Services Act Prevention and Early Intervention Plan in the maximum amount of \$149,297 for the contract term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Services are funded by Behavioral Health Services Act (BHSA) funding made available to Nevada County. Services are within the Department's budget. There are no county general fund dollars required in the agreement.

BACKGROUND: Nevada County and Placer County have historically partnered to co-fund services in the Tahoe Truckee region. Crisis Intervention Services (CIS) has successfully responded to past Request for Interest and has been providing key services in the region for many years in the areas of 1) **Latino Outreach & Engagement Services**; and 2) **Family Support and Family Strengthening Program**;

- 1) **Latino Outreach & Engagement Services:** Crisis Intervention Services has been serving the Latino population in Truckee since 2001. Through the Family Resource Centers To increase behavioral health **access, engagement, linkage and early intervention** for Latinx community members in Nevada County by reducing cultural, linguistic, and systemic barriers enhancing awareness of behavioral health services, and promoting equity in service utilization

Family Support and Family Strengthening Program: CIS will continue to provide responsive, accessible parenting education, support and engagement opportunities to families, including under-served and high-need populations, in Nevada County. The program will strengthen parent/caregiver skills, enhance child development outcomes, increase family resilience, and link families to broader behavioral health and community resources.

It is recommended that the Board approve the renewal contract which helps to increase the numbers of Latinos seeking behavioral health treatment and provide support for families and parents in accessing and receiving behavioral health services in the Tahoe/Truckee region.
