**SUBJECT:** Resolution accepting the FY 2022 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services funded through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$150,098 with a 100% matching fund requirement for use during the period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution

**FUNDING:** FY 2022 assignment of federal grant funds passed through the State in the amount of \$150,098 plus \$150,098 in County matching funds. The matching requirement will be met by a combination of the General Fund allocation to the Office of Emergency Services (OES) budget and work to be performed by other County departments on behalf of the OES program. These funds will be received in the Office of Emergency Services budget. A budget amendment is not required. There is no additional impact on the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:**

Funds provided under the EMPG must be used to support activities that contribute to the Operational Area's capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or manmade. The performance period for the FY 2022 EMPG is from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024.

The amount approved for Nevada County is \$150,098 with a 100% matching requirement. The matching requirement will be met by a combination of the General Fund allocation to the Office of Emergency Services (OES) budget and work to be performed by other County departments on behalf of the OES program.
