OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF A CAPITAL ASSET AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 INFORMATION SYSTEMS BUDGET FOR PURCHASE OF A NEXT GENERATION FIREWALL SYSTEM (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, the Chief Information Officer has recommended, and the Information System Steering Board has approved, purchase of a next generation firewall system to enhance protection of the County's data resources from Internet-based attacks; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorizes purchase of the following capital assets:

WatchGuard M4600 Firebox	\$18,275
WatchGuard High Availability M4600 Firebox	\$9,378

2. Directs the Auditor-Controller to reduce the Information Technology Assignment of the General Fund by \$64,053 (4/5 affirmative vote required) and amend the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Information Systems budget as follows:
