OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING A DRAFT OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA ON-SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL REGULATION AND RELATED DOCUMENTS WHICH COMPRISE THE PROPOSED DRAFT LOCAL AREA MANAGEMENT PLAN (LAMP) AND AUTHORIZE THE NEVADA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TO SUBMIT THE DRAFT TO THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD (CVRWQCB)

WHEREAS, on 19 June 2012, the SWRCB adopted Resolution No. 2012-0032 which, in part, approves the Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Systems (OWTS). The OWTS allows Local Agencies to propose Local Area Management Plans for Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board approval, as conditional waivers of Waste Discharge Requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is required by the State of California under Assembly Bill 885 for the County of Nevada Environmental Health Department to submit a LAMP to the CVRWQCB by May 13, 2016 or accept Tier 1 standards; and

WHEREAS, the OWTS requires Central Valley Water Board staff to solicit comments from the State of California Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water regarding a LAMP's proposed setbacks and notifications to water purveyors; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada Environmental Health Department has completed a draft LAMP for Board consideration, along with a preliminary completeness checklist; and

WHEREAS, no substantive changes or modifications to the previously approved OWTS are proposed, no substantial changes with respect to circumstances under which the LAMP will be undertaken have occurred, and no new information triggers the need for supplemental or subsequent CEQA analysis. The LAMP has been prepared wholly within the scope of the OWTS as analyzed by the SWRCB in the existing SED. As such, adoption and implementation of the LAMP does not require further environmental review pursuant to the certified regulatory program or CEQA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approves the draft LAMP and authorizes the Nevada County Department of Environmental Health to submit the draft LAMP and proposed draft Onsite Wastewater Treatment System Regulations and Manual to the CVRWQCB.
