OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AGENCY ON AGING AREA 4 IN SEPTEMBER OF 2023 FOR FIFTY YEARS OF SERVICE PROVIDED BY A DEDICATED STAFF AND COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY SUPPORT

WHEREAS, Agency on Aging Area 4 (AAAs) started in 1973 and was one of the first Agencies on Aging in the state of California. The expansion of services for older adults grew quickly in the early 70's in response to the funding made available by the Older Americans Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS, Agency on Aging Area 4 worked exclusively with Older American Act funding and contracted out all their services. The Agency worked with many local counties and in 1983 a Joint Powers Agreement between Nevada, Placer, Sacramento Sierra, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba counties developed to formalize this arrangement; and

WHEREAS, the Agency provides a range of options to older adults they may choose among home and community-based services and living arrangements that suit them best making it possible for older adults to "age in place" in their home and communities; and

WHEREAS, Agency on Aging Area 4 enriches the lives of older adults and people with disabilities by fostering networks of support, advocating for individual choice, collaborating with others, ensuring equity, and striving to do so with conviction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors on behalf of the citizens of Nevada County does hereby recognize the Agency on Aging Area 4's dedicated staff and commitment to community support, by celebrating fifty years of service, and the Board urges every resident to recognize the contributions Agency on Aging Area 4 has made in our community.
