SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Renewal of Contract for Leachate Transport

Services at the McCourtney Road Closed Landfill for an Amount not

to Exceed \$450,000

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Funding is for Fiscal Year 2019/20 and impacts the Solid Waste budget. Funding is provided by parcel charge assessments and no budget amendment is needed. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: On June 20, 2017, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 17-322 awarding a contract to Robinson Enterprises, Inc. for Leachate Transport Services at the McCourtney Road Closed Landfill on an "as needed" basis. On June 19, 2018, Per Resolution 18-277, the BOS approved the renewal of this agreement for a one-year term of July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2019.

Ongoing Leachate Transport Services are needed at the McCourtney Road Closed Landfill; therefore, staff is recommending a renewal of this agreement for an additional one-year contract term of July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, at a not-to-exceed amount of \$450,000. The contract will allow for the removal of more than five-million gallons of Leachate from the storage tanks per year.
