OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING AUGUST 2023 AS "CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH" IN NEVADA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS Nevada County's children have a right to receive emotional and financial support from both of their parents; and

WHEREAS, Sierra Nevada Regional Department of Child Support Services "SNRDCSS" is strongly committed to promoting the health and well-being of all of Nevada County's children by ensuring co-parents pay child support on a regular and timely basis, and encouraging all parents to have a loving and supportive relationship with their children; and

WHEREAS, SNRDCSS understands that every co-parent has different wants and needs for their children, but all have the same shared goal: to see those children thrive; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is a leader in child support program performance in California exceeding the statewide averages in all federal performance criteria. Last fiscal year, SNRDCSS collected more than \$6.9 million in child support payments that provided greater financial security and stability for the County's children and their families; and

WHEREAS, Child Support Awareness month is a call to action for Nevada County, reminding us that every family in all their diverse shapes and sizes, has different wants and needs, but we all have the same shared goal: protecting and uplifting the generations of our future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada proclaims August 2023 as "Child Support Awareness Month" in Nevada County.
