**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing Amendment #4 to the contract with Telmate, LLC for inmate phone services to comply with orders of the Federal Communications Commission pertaining to rate caps effective June 20, 2016

---

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

**FUNDING:** This is a revenue contract and monies are deposited in the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund to provide services for county inmates.

**BACKGROUND:** As the result of a competitive solicitation process, and as authorized by Board Resolution 11-161, the County entered into a contract in April 2011 with Telmate, LLC to provide inmate phone services at the Sheriff's Adult Detention Facilities (Wayne Brown Correctional Facility, Courthouse holding facility, and Truckee substation). The contract provides state of the art equipment and generates revenue to the Sheriff's Inmate Welfare Fund.

Under the proposed amendment #4, Exhibits A and B are revised. The revisions are necessary to comply with the Federal Communications Commission ruling for jails, effective June 20, 2016, related to fees pertaining to inmate phone calling service contracts. The mandated changes are expected to reduce funding for the Inmate Welfare Fund.

A prior Amendment #1, was approved by Resolution 12-393, Amendment #2 was approved by Resolution 15-118, and Amendment #3 was approved by Resolution 16-144.
