**BACKGROUND:** On February 24, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 09-077 approving new road names and an agreement with Caltrans regarding their Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Road Improvement Project. As such, a Relinquishment Agreement was approved by all parties on March 12, 2009, where the County agreed to waive the State's obligation to provide ninety (90) days prior notice of State's "Intention to Relinquish" as set forth in the Streets and Highway Code Section 73 and to accept ownership of the identified relinquished facilities. Specifically, those facilities now constitute portions of La Barr Meadows Road on the east side of Highway 49 and Golden Star Road and Allison Ranch Road on the west side of Highway 49. Now that the Caltrans project is complete, Caltrans has prepared Relinquishment Map 035933-X and requests a Resolution from the Board of Supervisors agreeing to accept the relinquished right of way.
