RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FRAUD GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,421.00 FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2016 TO JUNE 30, 2017

WHEREAS, the Nevada County District Attorney's Office applied for and has been awarded Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant Funds by the California Department of Insurance; and


WHEREAS, Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant Funds in the amount of \$25,421.00 have been made available for the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors desires to initiate an Automobile Insurance Fraud program to be funded in part from funds administered by the California Department of Insurance; and

WHEREAS, the Grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant existing expenditures controlled by this body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that provided that this Resolution shall be adopted by a four-fifths majority, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, accepts the Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant Funds in the amount of \$25,421.00 for use from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 to investigate and prosecute automobile insurance fraud and economic car theft cases, and authorizes the District Attorney to execute all necessary contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments for the purposes of securing these grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant funds shall be deposited into District Attorney Revenue Account 0101 20103 101 1000 445090.
