RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES BEHAVIORAL HEALTH – QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, to help counties prepare for CalAIM changes, the Behavioral Health – Quality Improvement Program (BH-QIP) will support county efforts to modernize and improve behavioral health finance, administration, and clinical performance; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department is eligible to receive up to \$730,089 over a three-year period as it reaches specific implementation milestones; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is charged with administering the BH-QIP program; and

WHEREAS, DHCS has developed an Initial Funding Request and a Certification Form for counties to submit in order to receive funds on a periodic basis; and

WHEREAS, this DHCS BH-QIP form requires certification by both the Auditor-Controller and the Behavioral Health Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Authorizes the Behavioral Health Director to request start-up funds for the Behavioral Health Quality Improvement Program.
- 2. Authorizes the Behavioral Health Director to sign and execute the BH-QIP Start Up Funding Claiming Form and periodic Certification Forms with the Department of Health Care Services, and any amendments thereof.
- 3. Authorizes the County Auditor-Controller, or designee, to sign and execute the BH-QIP Start Up Funding Claiming Form and periodic Certification Forms with the Department of Health Care Services, and any amendments thereof.

The Initial Funding Request and Certification form must be signed by the County Behavioral Health Director certifying that all claiming information sent to DHCS is accurate and complete and in accordance with law.
