OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND SCRAM OF CALIFORNIA, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,000, FOR THE CONTRACT PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2026, TO JUNE 30, 2027, FOR CONTINUOUS ALCOHOL MONITORING AND ELECTRONIC MONITORING

WHEREAS, AB 109 legislation requires each county to maintain its own Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) plan regarding use of sanctions and evidence-based practices to reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 129 provides funding and guidance for the Nevada County Superior Court to continue to support a local pretrial program operated by the Nevada County Probation Department; and

WHEREAS, the continuous alcohol monitoring and electronic monitoring programs are a productive alternative to incarceration which adhere to our use of sanctions and evidence-based practices to supervise, improve services, and reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into a Professional Services Contract dated July 1, 2025, which is set to expire on June 30, 2026, adopted by resolution 25-298.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County of Nevada and SCRAM of California, Inc., pertaining to providing continuous remote alcohol monitoring and electronic monitoring, for the contract term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount of \$60,000, be and hereby is approved contingent upon the adoption of the fiscal year 2026/27 County Budget, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada, and that the Auditor -Controller is directed to encumber \$60,000 for fiscal year 2026/27. All services are funded by the State Local Community Corrections Account apportionment and SB129 Pretrial funds.
