



RESOLUTION No. 26-025

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CAPITAL ASSET PURCHASE OF ONE MX908 DEVICE, UTILIZING THE 2025 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AWARD OF THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) MICROGRANT FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$82,737.98 (INCLUDING SALES TAX) AND AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF THE CAPITAL ASSET (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), offered a grant program known as the Microgrant; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office received notice that the 2025 COPS Microgrant has been awarded to the Nevada County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$175,000 and will be used for the purchase of a MX908 device (a device that identifies unknown substances in the field) and to fund year two of Peregrine Software Solutions contract; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors accepted the COPS Microgrant funding on December 16, 2025, (Resolution 25-565); and


WHEREAS, the MX908 device is a critical tool for threat detection and public safety, bridging the gap between lab-grade analysis of unidentified substances and field-ready deployment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

- 1) The above recitals are true and correct.
- 2) The capital asset purchase of the MX908 device is approved and authorizes the Nevada County Sheriff's Office to purchase the MX908 device in the amount of \$82,737.98.
- 3) The Auditor-Controller is directed to amend the Nevada County Sheriff's Office fiscal year 2025/26 budget (4/5 affirmative vote required) as follows:
