OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, APPROVING THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS FOR THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF STEEL MESH SAFETY FENCING, AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASING DIVISION TO SOLICIT BIDS FROM PRE-QUALIFIED CONTRACTORS FROM A REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS CONDUCTED EARLIER FOR THIS PROJECT

WHEREAS, Nevada County Sheriff's Office Correctional staff have identified the need for safety fencing at the second level and at the stairs within the Wayne Brown Correctional Facility; and

WHEREAS, security concerns limit the distribution of plans and drawings of the Wayne Brown Correctional Facility to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Plans and Specifications for the Design and Installation of Steel Mesh Safety Fencing are securely held by the Nevada County Facilities Department; and

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code Section 20101 allows for an initial Request for Qualifications to pre-qualify potential vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Request for Qualifications was released in April 2026; and

WHEREAS, three firms were determined to be qualified: Dynamic Trades, Inc., of Greenwood CA, Golden Bay Fence Plus Iron Works, Inc., of Stockton CA, and Pisor Fence Division Inc., of Antelope CA; and

WHEREAS, the bidding documents for this project are now complete; and

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code Section 20150.12 requires that the Board of Supervisors adopt the plans and specifications for all public works projects for which the expenditure exceeds \$10,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California:

1. Adopts the Plans and Specifications for the Design and Installation of Steel Mesh Safety Fencing.
2. Approves the bidding documents for the Design and Installation of Steel Mesh Safety Fencing, authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign the documents, and grants the Purchasing Agent the authorization to incorporate any final changes into the bid documents before advertising for bids.
3. Authorizes the Purchasing Division to solicit for bids to the qualified firms listed herein.
