OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

AUTHORIZATION OF PROCESS TO SELECT AN AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO FILL THE VACANCY DUE TO THE COURT'S RULING DISQUALIFYING THE ELECTED AUDITOR-CONTROLLER

WHEREAS, the current term of Auditor-Controller would normally end January 2, 2023 at noon; and

WHEREAS, Marcia Salter, the current Auditor-Controller, pursuant to Government Code section 24201 shall hold office until a successor is appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2022 the Nevada County Superior Court found that Rob Tribble was ineligible to hold the office of Auditor-Controller and ordered that the election of Mr. Tribble is annulled and set aside, creating a vacancy beginning January 2, 2023 at noon; and

WHEREAS, per California Government Code section 25304 the Board of Supervisors shall fill by appointment all elective County officer vacancies that arise before the end of the current term, 2023-2027; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to fill the office of the Auditor-Controller with a qualified appointee as required by California Government Code section 26945; and

WHEREAS, two options are proposed for the Board of Supervisors to use to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the two options are to make a direct appointment or to run a recruitment to fill the position, using an ad hoc selection committee appointed by the Chair of the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes a recruitment and selection process and timeline to fill the Auditor-Controller position through the term ending January 4, 2027 at noon.
