SUBJECT: Resolution approving Exhibit A to an agreement (Resolution No. 09-388)

between the County of Nevada and the County of Placer for the provision of Nevada County Connects Route 5 Service for Fiscal Year 2025/26 – Districts

II & III

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Funding for this Agreement is provided by Nevada County and Placer County from Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds in Fiscal Year 2025-26. There is no impact to the County general fund and a budget amendment is not required.

BACKGROUND:

For the past 25+ years, Nevada and Placer Counties have jointly sponsored Nevada County Connects (formerly Gold Country Stage) Route 5, which provides a limited stop-commuter service between Grass Valley and Auburn along the Highway 49 corridor Monday through Friday. The Route 5 agreement is automatically renewed on July 1 of each year, with approval of an updated calculation of Transit Service charges included in Exhibit A.

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution approving Exhibit A of the Agreement between the County of Nevada and the County of Placer for the Provision of Nevada County Connects Route 5 Service for Fiscal Year 2025-26 with a contract cost of \$89,449.
