RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING A SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATIONARY ENGINEERS LOCAL 39 PROFESSIONAL UNIT AND COUNTY OF NEVADA AUTHORIZING FREON AND PESTICIDE DIFFERENTIAL PAY OF 2.5% FOR ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the County entered into a side letter of agreement with Stationary Engineers, Local 39, Professional Bargaining Unit effective December 29, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to approve the attached Side Letter of Agreement which implements a special differential of 2.5% of base pay for those employees who have achieved and regularly utilize a certificate in the administration of Freon and pesticide as a regular part of their assigned duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, that the Side Letter of Agreement implementing a special differential of 2.5% of base pay for those employees in the Professional bargaining unit who have achieved and regularly utilize a certificate in the administration of Freon and pesticide as a regular part of their assigned duties is hereby accepted and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other compensation, fringe benefits, responsibilities and restrictions applicable to members of this employee unit remain unchanged.
