SUBJECT: Resolution approving an application for California Development Block Grant Disaster Relief Mitigation Resilience Program funding and the execution of a standard agreement and any amendments thereto, and certain related loan or grant documents and any amendments thereto, related to any award made pursuant to such application – District IV

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

FUNDING: The North San Juan Fire Suppression Project has thus far been funded through the General Fund via Economic Development. This resolution will allow for the application of the 2017 CDBG-DR Mitigation Resilience funding and increase the new not-to-exceed program award. This project is in the current Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Plan and has a Project Charter through Economic Development.

BACKGROUND: The North San Juan Fire Suppression Project involves construction of a 330,000-gallon water storage tank, approximately 4,200 ft of water mains and 10 fire hydrants in the commercial core of North San Juan to provide fire water storage and distribution for commercial and residential uses in the area. Completion of the project is intended to remove a barrier for economic development and provide a reliable robust means of fire water supply in North San Juan. Providing fire suppression within the commercial core of North San Juan is significant for fire safety because the community area serves as the only main fire break along the San Juan ridge. The project has been determined to have a less than significant environmental impact with mitigation measures, as approved by the Board of Supervisors on December 5, 2023 under Resolution 23-614.

In order to receive funding from the California Housing and Community Development Agency for the North San Juan Fire Suppression Project the Board of Supervisors has to approve the attached resolution increasing the Program Award to a new, not to exceed amount of \$5,659,981.00 and authorizes and directs the Applicant Authorized Signer or Designated Signer to execute and deliver all applications and act on Applicant's behalf in matters pertaining to all such applications.
