Re: Letter of Commitment regarding Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP)

Dear Ms. Bell,

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) agrees to fund the Nevada County Sutton Way Wellness Center project in the amount of \$1,999,975 through the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP) Round 3: Launch Ready funding. DHCS grants Nevada County Behavioral Health approval to acquire the property associated with the project, as represented in the grant application, located at 1103-1105 Sutton Way, Grass Valley, California 95945, prior to executing the required Standard Agreement using County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) funds temporarily in recognition that the acquisition needs to close escrow by September 15, 2022.

Additionally, DHCS agrees to reimburse Nevada County Behavioral Health for the acquisition of the stated property aforementioned, along with other costs incurred that align with the Nevada County BHCIP application budget, up to the maximum BHCIP grant amount awarded, as DHCS continues to finalize the Standard Agreement between Nevada County and Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP), the BHCIP administrative entity. The Standard Agreement would be executed by both parties as soon as possible, and County funds reimbursed upon approval of the reimbursement request, no later than December 31, 2022.
