**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing the purchase of a 2024 Ford F-600 with a utility body and 8000 lb. crane for the Sanitation Fleet

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** Funding is for fiscal year 2025/26 and is included in the Sanitation District Budget. There is no impact to the general fund.

**BACKGROUND:** The Sanitation District requests approval to purchase one new vehicle (2024 Ford F-600 with utility body and 8000 lb. crane). Some of the heavily used vehicles in the sanitation fleet have been identified as having the need to be replaced due to age, cost of maintenance, and the expanding service needs of the district. The existing Maintainer is approaching the end of its useful service life, and it will be replaced with this purchase. Funds had been set aside for the purchase of a Maintainer Crane Truck in the 25/26 budget. Fleet has identified a vehicle that meets Sanitation's needs, which can be purchased as soon as we have received board approval. This is a single source award as we have been unable to locate a service body F600 crane truck that is 4x4 with a gas engine and meets the crane specs needed. Future ford has one on the lot and can have it equipped with the service body and 8k lb. crane in 8/12 weeks. The truck we are looking for is not so popular with a gasoline engine. Sanitation needs a gas engine due to the usage of this truck and the extended idle times.

The purchase of this new vehicle requires the approval of a capital asset by the Board of Directors. The cost of the new vehicle is \$178,414.10 plus associated fees.
