RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AUTHORIZING NEVADA COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CALIFORNIA MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AUTHORITY CREDENTIALING AND RE-CREDENTIALING FOR CALIFORNIA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PLANS PROGRAM FOR THE PROVISION OF CREDENTIALING, RE-CREDENTIALING, AND MONTHLY MONITORING, INCREASING THE CONTRACT PRICE FROM \$65,800 TO \$90,308 (AN INCREASE OF \$24,508), EXTENDING THE CONTRACT TERMINATION DATE FROM JULY 31, 2026 TO JUNE 30, 2028, AMENDING EXHIBIT "A" SCHEDULE OF SERVICES TO INCLUDE UPDATED LANGUAGE AND AMENDING EXHIBIT "B" SCHEDULE OF CHARGES AND PAYMENTS TO REFLECT THE INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM CONTRACT PRICE (RES 25-065)

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2025 per Resolution 25-065, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorized the execution of the Participation Agreement between the County of Nevada and the California Mental Health Services Authority Credentialing and Recredentialing for California County Behavioral Health Plans Program for the provision of credentialing, re-credentialing, and monthly monitoring; and

WHEREAS, the State and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) have published various uniform provider credentialing and recredentialing requirements that County mental Health Plans and Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery Systems (DMC-ODS) must follow; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department has entered into a contract with the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) Semi-Statewide Electronic Health Record Program for the services related to a California-centric Electronic Health Record (EHR); and

WHEREAS, CalMHSA is a Joint Power Authority representing County Behavioral Health Departments under the authority of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, CalMHSA has developed a process for services related to the credentialing process, which may include registration, certification, licensure, and/or professional association membership, along with ongoing monthly monitoring of provider databases and exclusion lists. Credentialing ensures that providers are licensed, registered, waived, and/or certified as required by state and federal law; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department entered into a participation agreement with CalMHSA for Credentialing and Recredentialing to meet state and federal credentialing and re-credentialing requirements; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend their Agreement to increase the contract price from \$65,800 to \$90,308 (an increase of \$24,508), amend Exhibit "A" Schedule of Services to

include updated language, extend the contract termination date from July 31, 2026 to June 30, 2028, amend Exhibit "B", Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Amendment No. 1 to the Participation Agreement by and between the CalMHSA, pertaining to the provision of the CalMHSA credentialing and re-credentialing services for the contract term of March 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028, in the maximum amount of \$90,308 be and hereby is approved, and that the Director of Behavioral Health be and is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment and any necessary documents in connection with this agreement thereto, on behalf of the County of Nevada.

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
