Nevada County Eligibility and Employment workers tirelessly help the citizens of Nevada County with a wide array of services. They administer public assistance programs that reduce food insecurity, strengthen health outcomes, provide safety and security, and develop valuable workplace skills to support our local families and assist with the journey to self-sufficiency

OVER THE LAST YEAR

This past year Eligibility and Employment programs have provided the following to our community:

PROVIDED 1,220 EMERGENCY FOOD BAGS TO CUSTOMERS IN WESTERN AND EASTERN COUNTY

PROVIDED 9,059 INDIVIDUALS WITH CALFRESH OR FOOD BENEFITS.

SUPPORTED 55 FAMILIES WITH PERMANENT HOUSING AND 45 WITH TRANSITIONAL HOUSING.

PROVIDED 25,725 INDIVIDUALS WITH HEALTH CARE COVERAGE THROUGH MEDI-CAL.

PLACED 40 PARTICIPANTS IN SUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS WITH BUSINESSES AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.

ISSUED OVER \$43,989,241 OF FEDERAL AND STATE FUNDS THAT WERE SPENT IN OUR COMMUNITY SUPPORTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.


