OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE CURRENT ADULT AND FAMILY SERVICES COMMISSION (AFSC) MEMBERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NEVADA COUNTY AFSC BYLAWS

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors created the Adult and Family Services Commission (AFSC) pursuant to Resolution 05-041 on February 8, 2005, and as amended by Resolutions 05-179 on May 24, 2005, and 06-589 on December 12, 2006, and ratified amendments to the AFSC Bylaws on June 14, 2011, and January 9, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the January 9, 2018, amendments to the AFSC Bylaws include a reduction in the number of commissioners from eighteen (18) to twelve (12), and modified the sectors of the community from seven (7) to (3), which now consist of a Public Sector, a Low Income Sector, and a Private Sector, with each Sector comprised of four Commission members; and

WHEREAS, the reduction of the number of Sectors from which Commission members are selected necessitates the reclassification of existing Commission members; and

WHEREAS, the AFSC reviewed the proposed member reclassifications and approved, in accordance with the democratic selection process set forth in the AFSC Bylaws, submitting the attached proposed reclassifications of current commission members to align with the modified sectors from which members are to be selected to the Nevada County Board of Supervisors for review and ratification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the reclassification of the current Adult and Family Services Commission (AFSC) members in accordance with the Nevada County AFSC Bylaws in substantially the form attached hereto is hereby ratified.
