OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH FREED INDEPENDENT LIVING CENTER, DBA FREED, FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE FRIENDLY VISITOR PROGRAM AND PROGRAM TO ENCOURAGE ACTIVE REWARDING LIVES (PEARLS), IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$71,812, FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2026, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027

WHEREAS, FREED Center for Independent Living (FREED) is an agency that supports independent living for adults with disabilities and older adults; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Behavioral Health wishes to enter into a renewal contract with FREED, who will operate the Friendly Visitor program and Program to Encourage Active, Rewarding Lives (PEARLS), as funded by the Behavioral Health Services Act; and

WHEREAS, these programs aid in comforting individuals experiencing isolation, depression, anxiety, or other emotional or health issues, as well as providing appropriate intervention and linkages to community resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between Nevada County and FREED, for the provision of services pertaining to the Friendly Visitor program and PEARLS, for the term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount of \$71,812, be and hereby is approved, and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County Budget. The contract begins on July 1, 2026.
