RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the resolution accepting the California Department of Cannabis Control Local Jurisdiction Assistance Grant Funds in the amount of \$1,221,188.00 and amend the Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Cannabis budget in the amount of \$199,665.00.

<u>FUNDING</u>: The County of Nevada has been awarded \$1,221,188.00 from the California Department of Cannabis Control Local Jurisdiction Assistance Grant Funds.

BACKGROUND: On November 10, 2021, Nevada County applied for the California Department of Cannabis Control Local Jurisdiction Assistance Grant funding. The County was notified on December 24, 2021, that the funds were awarded in the amount of \$1,221,188.00 and shall be expended by the grant term expiration date of March 31, 2025.

Once the funds are accepted, the Community Development Agency will utilize these funds in the following areas:

- Environmental consultants
- Environmental site development
- Grant administration
- Increase staff resources and space planning

The additional resources the funding provides will support the cannabis local equity program and assist qualified individuals to successfully operate legally in the state and local cannabis market.
