



RESOLUTION No. 19-579

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FUNDED THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$177,017 FOR USE DURING THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2019 THROUGH MAY 31, 2022

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security is funding a grant through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to provide funding to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other catastrophic events; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 15-396 approves individuals as authorized officials to execute applications and documents for Department of Homeland Security Programs on behalf of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County's application was approved by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services and Notification of Approval has been signed and received on September 26, 2019; and

WHEREAS, each Operational Area must appoint an Anti-Terrorism Approval Body to have final approval on the implementation of Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) funds; and

WHEREAS the Approval Body shall consist of the County Public Health Officer, County Fire Chief, Municipal Fire Chief, County Sheriff and Chief of Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby directs:

1. That the County of Nevada accept the grant in the amount of \$177,017 for the grant period September 1, 2019 through May 31, 2022.
2. That the Director of Emergency Services is authorized to fulfill the requirements of the Fiscal Year 2019 Homeland Security Grant Program.
3. That the Auditor-Controller deposit grant funding in the amount of \$177,017 into the Emergency Management Budget 0101-20702-414-1000/446700, as funding is received.
