RESOLUTION TO ELIMINATE ADMINISTRATIVE FEES PERTAINING TO THE HOME DETENTION PROGRAM FOR PARTICPANTS 21 YEARS OF AGE AND YOUNGER AS REQUIRED BY SENATE BILL 190 (2017-2018)


WHEREAS, Penal Code 1203.016 establishes guidelines for the Home Detention Program and provides that the Board of Supervisors may authorize the program including its conditions and fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, by adopting Resolution 10-108, authorized the Sheriff to administer the Home Detention Program and prescribe administrative fees; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2017, the Governor of the State of California signed into law Senate Bill 190 (2017-2018) which amended Penal Code Section 1203.016(g). The new law, in effect January 1, 2018, no longer allows for the collection of Home Detention Program administrative fees for participations 21 years of age or younger; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the amended law, the administrative fees portion of the Home Detention Program must be adjusted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, that the resolution to eliminate fees for participants 21 years old and younger in the Home Detention Program is hereby adopted.
