OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENCE EMERGENCY DISASTER ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND THE GOLDEN STATE FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR GRANT FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$19,098 TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY HOUSING AND SHELTER ASSISTANCE ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2017 WIND COMPLEX FIRES AND AUTHORIZING THE NEVADA COUNTY DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Golden State Financing Authority (“GSFA”) is a joint powers authority serving thirty-three rural county members in California and various additional associate county and city members to provide housing down payment assistance, energy efficiency, and other financing programs; and

WHEREAS, the GSFA Board of Directors has approved GSFA Resolution 17-10 to assist GSFA member counties in providing temporary shelters and housing for their citizens impacted by the Wind Complex fires of 2017; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is a member of GSFA and has been awarded grant funding in an amount not to exceed \$19,098 to provide temporary housing and shelter assistance associated with the 2017 Wind Complex fires; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding must be expended in accordance with the terms of the Agreement within two years from receipt of payment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby directs:

1. That the County of Nevada accept the award in an amount not to exceed \$19,098 to be expended within a two year period according to the terms of the Agreement.
2. That the Agreement for Residence Emergency Disaster Assistance between the County of Nevada and the GSFA (“Agreement”) be and hereby is approved.
3. That the Nevada County Director of Emergency Services is authorized to execute the Agreement, provide progress reports are required by the Agreement and generally fulfill the requirements of the Agreement.
4. That the Auditor-Controller deposit grant funding in the amount of \$19,098 into the Emergency Management Budget 0101-20702-414-1000/462400 when received.
