SUBJECT: (Waive further reading/Adopt) Ordinance amending, adding, and repealing non-substantive sections of the Nevada County General Code

RECOMMENDATION: Waive further reading and adoption of the proposed Ordinance.

FUNDING: The revisions will have no fiscal effect.

BACKGROUND:

The Codes of the County of Nevada were last fully updated in 2006 by Ordinance No. 2192. To create uniformity in internal referencing and language usage; updated pronouns; agency and departmental organization; and to verify accuracy of citation and comport with state statutes, County Counsel's Office has been working with County agencies and departments and proposes the following revisions.

During this thorough review of all County Codes, revisions that are substantive in nature or which may require companion resolutions are not being brought forward at this time.

The proposed revisions serve the following functions:

- Updated language to reflect established practices within the department;
- Corrections to comply with current California statutes; and
- Editorial corrections to create uniformity within the County Codes.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Board adopt this proposed Ordinance to amend, repeal, and/or add the following codes:
