
RESOLUTION TO APPROVE INDIVIDUALS AS AUTHORIZED OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE APPLICATIONS AND DOCUMENTS FOR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, Nevada County, through its Office of Emergency Services, will apply for financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and subgranted through the State of California, for grants that are non-controversial, non-competitive and are renewed periodically; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security and the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services requires the designation of officials authorized to execute documents; and

WHEREAS, applications and documents sent to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services for purposes of said grants may be signed by the individuals assigned to the positions below.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, that the positions of the Director of Emergency Services, County Executive Officer, and Assistant County Executive Officer are authorized to execute for and on behalf of the County of Nevada, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California. The acceptance of all Grants will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval per County policy.
