OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA RESOLUTION AMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING AND THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO PERTAINING TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ROUND 1 FUNDING

WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (“HCD”) announced the availability of approximately \$18.7 million in funding for the Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) Coronavirus Response Round 1 (“CDBG-CV1”) funding for local assistance; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG-CV1 application was due on August 31, 2020, and the Health and Human Services Agency (“HHS”) received authorization to apply for funding per Resolution 20-357 on August 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this CDBG-CV1 funding is made available pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (“CARES”) Act; and

WHEREAS, upon authorization and approval by the Board of Supervisors HHS prepared and submitted an application in the amount of up to \$257,134, the maximum available for Nevada County; and

Whereas, HCD has requested that the original Resolution be amended to meet specific funding requirements; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of a grant agreement, the Director of Health and Human Services, or designee, is authorized to sign the standard agreement with the State of California for the purposes of this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, does hereby authorize the submittal of one or more application(s) in the aggregate amount of \$257,134 for the following CDBG-CV1 activities, pursuant to the January 2020 CDBG NOFA, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes as follows:

SECTION 1:

List activities and amounts

Public Service Program: Homeless Assistance	\$ 50,000
Housing Program: Mortgage Assistance	\$ 107,134

<u>Total CDBG Funding Application:</u>	<u>\$ 257,134</u>
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SECTION 2:

The County acknowledges compliance with state and federal public participation requirements in the development of this application.

SECTION 3:

The County hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Health and Human Services, to sign this application and act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to this application.

SECTION 4:

If the application is approved, the Director of Health and Human Services, or designee, is authorized to enter into and sign the grant agreement and any subsequent amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of this grant.

SECTION 5:

If the application is approved, the Director of Health and Human Services or designee, is authorized to sign Funds Requests and other required reporting forms.

SECTION 6:

The Director of Health and Human Services or designee, will return to the Board of Supervisors to provide an informational update should the application be approved.
