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**MEETING DATE:** January 10, 2017

**TO:** Board of Supervisors

**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of an amendment to the renewal contract with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Tuberculosis Control Branch (TBCB), which increases the Real-time Allotment from \$3,650 to \$20,699 (an increase of \$17,049) to support TB prevention and control activities for Fiscal Year 2016/17.

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** State and Federal funds. Availability of these funds will preserve Public Health Realignment for other use and there are no County General Funds required in this Agreement. A budget amendment is necessary and will be addressed in the County Wide Budget Amendment #2.

**BACKGROUND:** Per Administrative Contract No. 1182, the County Executive Officer approved the initial funding for the renewal contract for Fiscal Year 2016/17 in the amount of \$3,650 on June 28, 2016. The Real-time allotment has increased for Fiscal Year 2016/17 to the Board of Supervisors level of signing authority.

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Tuberculosis Control Branch (TBCB) provides financial assistance to local health jurisdictions to support core TB control and prevention activities. Funds are made available annually as Base Awards to eligible jurisdictions based on average case counts. Additional funds are made available for helping local TB programs ensure that persons with TB are able to complete treatment. The allotment can be used for allowable expenditures including Food, Shelter, Incentives and Enablers (FSIE) for TB patients, contacts to TB patients and patients who are suspected of having TB. FSIE items are to be used to enhance treatment adherence,

prevent homelessness, and/or promote least restrictive alternatives that decrease or eliminate the need for detention.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment as the additional funds will help support TB control and prevention activities in Nevada County.
