## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

### RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MARCH 1, 2026, THROUGH MARCH 7, 2026, AS NATIONAL WEIGHTS AND MEASURES WEEK

WHEREAS, the first week of March commemorates the signing of the first United States weights and measures law on March 2, 1799; and

WHEREAS, a uniform and reliable system of weights and measures is essential to a fair and equitable marketplace; and

WHEREAS, the County's Department of Agriculture, Weights and Measures inspects and certifies commercial weighing and measuring devices, verifies pricing, and enforces measurement standards that safeguard both buyers and sellers; and

WHEREAS, these services strengthen the County's economic landscape by increasing consumer confidence, supporting small and locally owned businesses, and ensuring that all enterprises can compete fairly and efficiently; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors recognizes the importance of these services in promoting transparency, fairness, and confidence for residents and businesses throughout the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims March 1, 2026, through March 7, 2026, as National Weights and Measures Week and encourages residents, businesses, and community partners to join in recognizing the essential role of weights and measures in supporting a fair and thriving economy.
