SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment No 1 to the Software License and Support Agreement with JUMP Technology Services, LLC for access to the automated elder care and dependent adult services system for Adult Protective Services (APS), known as AACTS to increase the contract price from \$34,040 to \$34,940 (an increase of \$900) and amend Exhibit "F" to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price for the contract term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022.(RES 19-378)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Services will be funded by Federal, State and Department realignment dollars. Services are included within the Department's FY 2021/22 budget and there are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: The County previously had a long-standing contract with McWilliams Mailliard Technology Group, Inc. (MMTG), for these services per Purchase Order and had automatically renewed annually via Purchase Order. Under this Agreement with JUMP, the County will contract under the existing contract for a period of three years.

The Department desired to access the automated elder care and dependent adult services system for Adult Protective Services (APS), known as AACTS as developed and offered by JUMP for the purpose of APS intake, case management and reporting requirements.

Per resolution 19-378 approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 9, 2019, JUMP granted licenses to the County for use of its software as a service product(s) on a Web Portal/Host system and provide general support, product support, system support and technical and user training.

It is recommended that this Resolution be passed as it will enable the Department continued access to automated data for elder and dependent adult services necessary for State reporting requirements.
