SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment No. 1 to the renewal contract with RDA Consulting for the provision of consulting services to extend the contract termination date from June 30, 2026 to December 31, 2026, with no change to the maximum contract price of \$99,825. (RES. 25-245)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: This agreement is funded with HHSA Administration Non-Distributable funds. Services are within the Department's proposed FY 2025/26 budget and there are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement. No additional fund will be used with this amendment.

BACKGROUND: On June 24, 2025, per Resolution 25-245, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with RDA Consulting (RDA) for consulting services to increase the Department's administrative capacity, including project management, strategy and organizational consultation, research, communications, and community input processes.

RDA assists the Health and Human Services Agency by providing a variety of consulting services to increase the Agency's administrative capacity, including project management, strategy and organizational consultation, research, communications, and community input processes as it relates to CalAIM. Activities may include facilitation of internal and external meetings, communication with Partnership HealthPlan of CA, our contracted managed care plan, milestone tracking and project management, and implementation assistance with Enhanced Care Management (ECM) and Community Supports (CS) services. Specific focus has been the successful launch of ECM for Public Health's California Children's Services (CCS) program. This no-cost extension will enable RDA to support Public Health with a sustainability strategy

and completion of a grant report due in July 2026.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment as it enhances the administrative capacity of the Health and Human Services Agency to address the significant changes and opportunities in service delivery and programming under the CalAIM initiative and specifically provides timely support to Public Health for the new ECM CSS program.
