WHEREAS, United Way of Nevada County is celebrating its fortieth year in the community and its mission is to improve lives by directing community resources to local needs; and

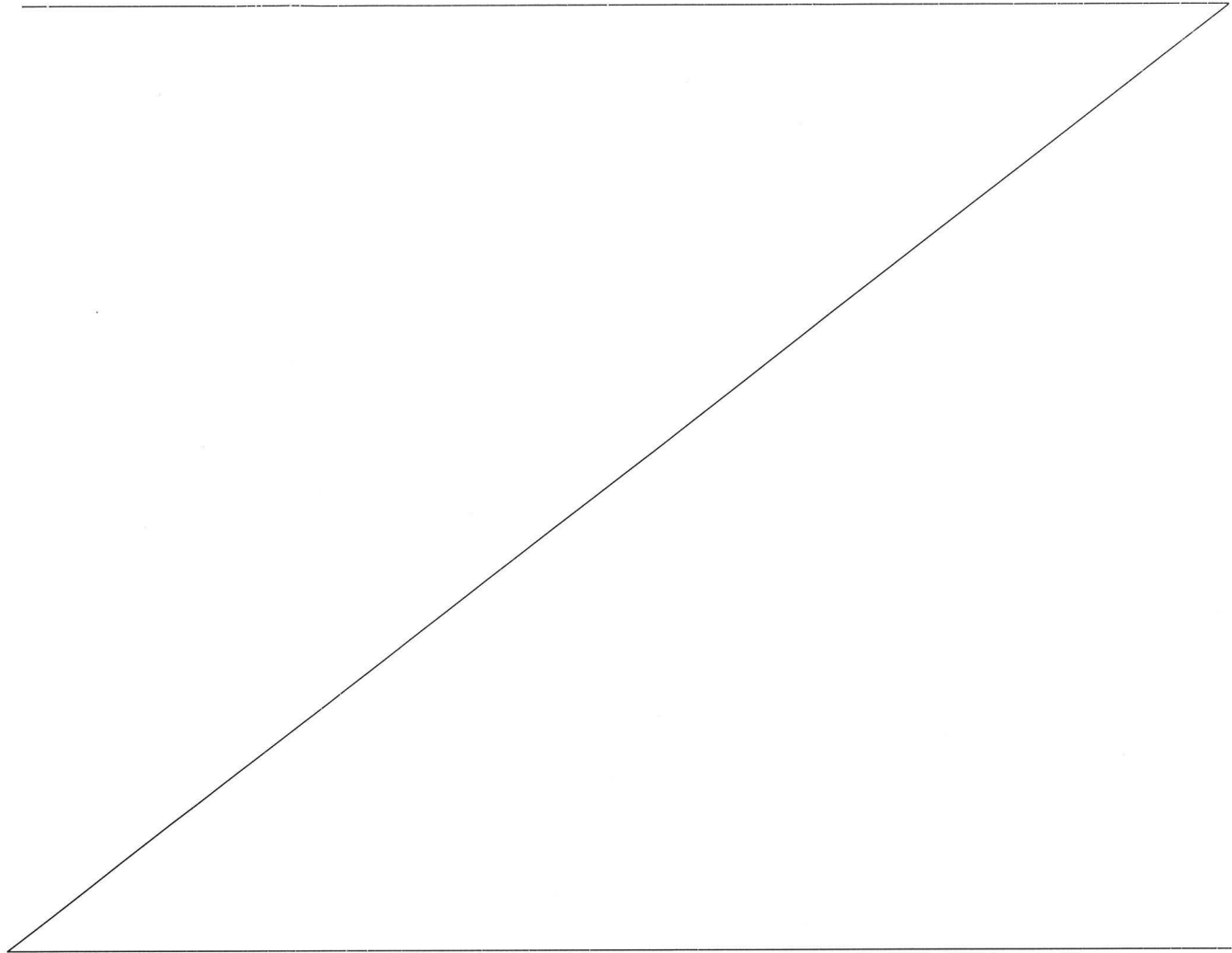
