**BACKGROUND:** On March 11, 2025 the Board of Supervisors received a federal legislative update presentation on recent federal advocacy efforts in Washington D.C, in coordination with the 2025 National Association of Counties (NACo) Legislative Conference. Upon receiving the presentation, the Board directed staff to bring back a policy resolution outlining its concerns regarding threats to County core services and local impacts associated with recent federal actions.
