SUBJECT: Resolution Proclaiming a Local Emergency in Nevada County Due to the Jones Fire (4/5 Vote Required)

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

FUNDING: The initial response actions will be from the General Fund and will depending on scale be supplemented by the State/Federal Government.

BACKGROUND:

Much of California has been experiencing extreme fire danger caused by a prolonged heat wave and dangerous weather conditions. In the early morning hours of August 17, 2020, a wildfire commenced near Jones Bar Road, northwest of Nevada City, which has since been named the “Jones Fire.” The Jones Fire has threatened the health, safety, and property of thousands of Nevada County residents living in and around the fire zone and has resulted in mass mandatory and voluntary evacuations and the destruction of homes and structures.

On August 17, 2020, at approximately 4:30 a.m., Nevada County commenced emergency services to respond to the Jones Fire, including opening its emergency shelters to provide food, shelter, emergency supplies, social services, medical attention, and transportation for evacuees and their animals, as well as other necessary services to address the rapidly changing and emergent circumstances created by the fire. In response to the escalation of the fire activity and corresponding threat to residents of Nevada County, on August 18, 2020, the Director of Emergency Services for the County of Nevada proclaimed the existence of a local emergency.

On the same day, the Governor of California declared a statewide emergency to help ensure the availability of vital resources to combat fires burning across the state, which have been exacerbated by the effects of the historic West Coast heat wave and sustained high winds. Additionally, the Governor secured Fire Management Assistance Grants (FMAGs) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to bolster the state’s response to fires burning in Napa, Nevada, and Monterey counties.

The conditions created by the Jones Fire, and the necessary emergency response services and activities to address the resulting impacts, are likely to continue and remain beyond the control, capacity, and resources of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of Nevada County, thereby constituting the existence of a local emergency and emergency situation as set forth in California Government Code sections 8630 and 54956. Such conditions

In furtherance of this local emergency proclamation, it is requested that the Emergency Services Director for the County of Nevada be designated as the authorized representative of the County of Nevada for the purpose of receipt, processing, and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain available State and Federal assistance, and that the powers, duties, and functions of the Director of Emergency Services, or his designee, and the emergency organization of the County, be those prescribed by state law, local ordinance and resolutions of this County approved by the Board of Supervisors.

The additional powers authorized by this proclamation of a local emergency will promote the health and well-being residents impacted by the Jones Fire through the coordination of local response and relief efforts, the seeking out and utilization of mutual aid, the obtaining of any/all available state and federal funding to assist with the local emergency, and the identification of other available resources deemed necessary to fully address the current and expected continuing impacts caused by the fire. Accordingly, it is requested that the Board of Supervisors adopt the Resolution Proclaiming a Local Emergency in Nevada County due to the Jones Fire.
