## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

### **RESOLUTION APPROVING A ZERO-COST CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR THE COUNTY TO CONTINUE TO UTILIZE VEHICLES PURCHASED WITH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CONTINUUM INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM (BHCIP) FUNDS AFTER THE END OF THE GRANT. THE CONTRACT HAS A TERM OF JULY 1, 2025 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2031**

WHEREAS, Nevada County Behavioral Health entered into a contract with Advocates for Human Potential, (RES 22-208) to receive grant funds through the Crisis Care Mobile Units grant, as a component of the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (BHCIP); and

WHEREAS, Advocates for Human Potential served as the grant administrator for the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) BHCIP; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds were for the purpose of implementing and enhancing 24/7 mobile crisis services within the county; and

WHEREAS, BHCIP grant funds were used to purchase a vehicle for the purpose of delivery of mobile crisis services in Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the contract for BHCIP funding related to mobile crisis services ended on June 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, DHCS has required BHCIP recipients to enter into a zero-cost vehicle use agreement in order to maintain possession of equipment purchased with grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and the Department of Health Care Services pertaining to the zero-cost vehicle use agreement to continue utilizing vehicles purchased with BHCIP grant funds for the contract term of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2031 and hereby is approved, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and any necessary certifications on behalf of the County of Nevada.
