SUBJECT:	Informational presentation from the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services and CAL FIRE Nevada-Yuba-Placer Unit regarding the 2025 Fire Season Outlook in Nevada County.

RECOMMENDATION: Accept the presentation from the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services and CAL FIRE Nevada-Yuba-Placer Unit.

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Office of Emergency Services (OES) works under the Emergency Preparedness Board Objective, leading the community in all hazards planning, preparedness, response, and recovery with a focus on wildfire. OES focuses on improving county-wide evacuation routes and safety, continuing to strengthen early alert and critical communication systems, and working with residents and community partners in emergency preparedness, defensible space, home hardening, green waste disposal, and fire-safe land stewardship.

In support of this objective, Nevada County OES, alongside CAL FIRE Unit Chief Brian Estes will present on the 2025 Fire Season Outlook. The presentation will include a review of previous fire season outcomes in Nevada County and an update on the fire weather outlook for the remainder of 2025, with reference to staffing levels and resources. Resources and programs available to residents to support wildfire preparedness including Free Community Green Waste and the County-wide Ready Nevada County mailer will be referenced.
