
RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT FROM
THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY
SERVICES FUNDED THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF
HOMELAND SECURITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$142,496 WITH A
100 PERCENT MATCH REQUIREMENT FOR USE DURING THE
PERIOD JULY 1, 2024, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026,
RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
EMERGENCY SERVICES TO EXECUTE THE GRANT
AGREEMENT AND ALL ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED
TO FULFILL THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE GRANT ON
BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security is funding a grant through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to assist state, local, and tribal governments to enhance their capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or man-made; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County's subaward was approved by the California Emergency Management Agency on October 28, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada hereby directs:

- 1. That the County of Nevada accept the grant in the amount of \$142,496 for the grant period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2026.
- 2. That the Director of Emergency Services is authorized retroactively to execute the grant agreement for Fiscal Year 24 Emergency Management Performance Grant.
- 3. That the Director of Emergency Services, County Executive Officer, and Assistant County Executive Officer are authorized sign all documents necessary to fulfill the requirements of the Fiscal Year 24 Emergency Management Performance Grant.
- 4. That the Auditor-Controller deposit grant funding in the amount of \$142,496 into the Emergency Management Budget 0101-20702-414-1000/446700 as funding is received.

This subaward is subject to requirements in Title 2 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, including the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO), the Preparedness Grants Manual, the California Supplement to the NOFO, reporting requirements, and all applicable federal, state, and local requirements. All activities funded with this subaward must be completed within the subaward performance period.

Your organization will be required to prepare and submit the Biannual Strategy Implementation Report (BSIR) to Cal OES semi-annually for the duration of the subaward period of performance or until all activities are completed and the subaward is formally closed. Throughout the subaward cycle, milestones set in the BSIR will be used as indicators of project feasibility, performance, and grant management capacity. This information may also be used in assessing proposals in future grant opportunities. Failure to submit required reports could result in subaward reduction, suspension, or termination.

Subrecipients must obtain additional approval **prior** to incurring costs for activities such as aviation, watercraft, allowability request logs, noncompetitive procurement, and projects requiring Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation review.
