SUBJECT: Resolution approving Amendment No. 3 to the professional services contract between the County of Nevada and Serrano Advisors, LLC to increase the maximum amount of the contract from \$49,875 to \$74,875 for fiscal year 2025-2026 and authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the amendment.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

FUNDING: Contract in the original amount of \$49,875 and contract amendment in the amount of \$25,000, for a total of \$74,875 in fiscal year 2025-2026, is 100% funded by CalAIM PATH 3 grant funds. No general funds are required.

BACKGROUND:

In October of 2024, the county entered into a contract with Serrano Advisors, LLC to provide planning and implementation for the CalAIM PATH 3 dollars that were awarded to the Probation Department for the implementation of reentry services. The Probation Department implementation team and Serrano Advisors began meeting in November of 2024, to develop an implementation plan and budget. Throughout the process DHCS indicated the approval of the budget would be a simple process. This didn't end up being the case with the Probation Department implementation team and Serrano Advisors having to conduct numerous additional meetings to land upon an approved budget.

The above, coupled with the need to complete the Facility Readiness Assessment requires an increase in the contracted number of hours by 66, taking the overall contracted hours to 199. The resulting increase in the overall budget from \$49,875 to \$74,875 requires the entire contract to be brought before the Board. The potential need for additional consultant time was anticipated and built into the overall PATH 3 grant budget of \$1,068,000.
