SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the acceptance of a Federal Aviation Administration grant in the amount of \$83,250 to fund the design of reconstructing of Ramp 4 taxilanes and access road at the Nevada County Airport; and authorizing the Airport Manager to execute the grant.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

FUNDING: The total cost of designing the reconstruction and crack repair of taxilanes and access road on ramp 4 at the Nevada County Airport is estimated at \$92,500. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is expected to fund 90% of the cost, or \$83,250 and CALTRANS Division of Aeronautics is expected to fund 4.5% of the cost, or \$4,163. The remaining 5.5% of the cost, or \$5,087 will be funded by the Airport Enterprise Fund. There is no impact to the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Board approved Resolution 23-600 authorized the airport manager to submit an application for a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and a CALTRANS matching project grant for design of reconstructing Ramp 4 taxilanes and access road at the Nevada County Airport. The CalTrans Division of Aeronautics grant when awarded will be brought to the Board as a separate item. This resolution will authorize the acceptance of the Airport Improvement Plan grant from the FAA in the amount of \$83,250 for the design of reconstructing of Ramp 4 taxilanes and access road at the Nevada County Airport.
