To the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

I request that the Board take no immediate action on the proposed Emergency Ordinance on the 8/11/20 Agenda, for the following reasons:

As you know, pursuant to a proclamation by the County Health Department dated March 5, 2020, a local emergency was declared by the Board on March 10, 2020,, declaring “extreme peril” “likely to be beyond the control, capacity, and resources of the ... facilities of Nevada County ...” and asking the “Governor to maintain a State of Emergency for the County of Nevada.” The County is required by statute to end the local emergency as soon as possible. To do so, they must revisit the basis for maintaining a current state of emergency. Statutorily the County is responsible to provide for the “*protection of life and property.*” Two prongs of consideration.

At present, the statistics in Nevada County do not support the Board continuing their declaration of emergency based upon the “**protection of life.**” It is insufficient to consider at this point one valuable elderly person’s demise, who passed approximately five months ago and I am confident medical professional and similar experts would certainly agree, had at least two life threatening co-morbidities that actually caused this death. I am informed and believe that as a general matter approximately 80 persons per month die in Nevada County, or 400 other persons have died in the intervening months, which deaths were not COVID-19 related. Likewise, since Nevada County began tracking the COVID testing from March 16 to the present (8/10/2020), there have been a total of 2 hospitalizations, 300 recovered and 22 currently active cases and 13,183 tested in a population separated by the East and West substantial geographic divide. With a population of more than 98,765 persons, the death rate in Nevada County is therefore .001% in 5 months (1/thousandths of one percent) and 322 confirmed cases (not necessarily symptomatic persons as it indicates there are approximately 21 active cases) or .3% (3/10ths of one percent) over five (5) months.

The Board’s duty under when declaring an emergency per the statutes also includes terminating the emergency absent a need for the “**protection of property.**” As you know, continuation of the declaration of emergency and the currently proposed “Emergency Ordinance” is actually doing substantial harm if not destroying altogether local business, which are the lifeblood and pocketbook of Nevada County and City governments. The proposed “Emergency” to protect life, as explained above, does not exist in this County. There was no emergency threatening “property.” Initially, the “Emergency Ordinance” for protection of life has effected critical harm to private sector businesses and tax revenues, while all scrambled to understand the apparent threat. As the “life threatening” emergency does not now exist, this threat has actually become actionable as a taking of private property and inverse condemnation. The current County proposed “Emergency Ordinance” is not based upon

statutory law or a pending emergency based upon verifiable science or facts; therefore, the proposed Emergency Ordinance violates the due process clauses of the U. S. (Fifth Amendment) and California (Art. I) Constitutions, as well as your oath of office thereto, specifically require the Board protect of life, liberty and property. To adopt the Ordinance instead constitutes kicking them when they are already down in the name of an emergency that no longer exists. Nevada County already has an unfunded pension plan liability of \$200,000,000 plus. Denying business operations in Nevada County would be devastating to the county budget and jeopardize former and future retired personnel' pensions.

Statutorily, the County's public health officer is required to address the Board with facts and petition the Governor in the strongest terms to address Nevada County's situation of non-emergency. He certainly should not be a rubber stamp. In May the Governor claimed there was a health "menace." That is not the case in our County. This is a conclusory term without substance in our circumstances. The Board must require the local health department to address all the "facts," not unsubstantiated conclusions. The lack of substantiation specific to Nevada County is especially troubling given the Health Officer was given a retroactive raise of \$55,000, bringing his total salary to a whopping \$266,000 per year, while only required to work 28 days per week and also collecting a pension. More is required of this Board the Health Department it directs.

Statutorily, the Governor *cannot* temporarily suspend safety statutes or regulations, yet he has done so and specifically exempted the state (not the cities or counties) from liability. In application, cities and counties have set aside long-standing OSHA regulations believing this is what the Governor ordered under the State Health Department "guidelines." This includes ignoring OSHA regulations and requiring mandatory masks. Although the State Health Department provides exemptions, in reality they are not being applied nor are OSHA *mandated* protocols being used by businesses or the County prior to mandating and now proposed enforcement through criminal laws and sanctions. This opens the businesses up to wrongful death and personal injury claims, in which they will seek indemnification from cities and counties. The Governor's orders are vague and it is the County's duty to nullify and not obey them or accept the liability (the Governor has carefully included language to exempt the State from liability.) As an example, at least one executive order includes language that residents are to "heed" State public health "directive to the state," whereas the state health department refers to these so-called "directives" as "guidelines," All are inaccurately interchangeably referred to as "orders." The County now proposes not heeding them as criminal in nature.

Additionally, the Governor has no statutory authority to suspend the open meeting laws of the Brown Act or Bagley-Keene Acts beyond the initial 60 days and in any event the Governor advised local agencies to "use sound discretion and to make reasonable efforts to adhere as closely as reasonably possible to the provisions [those Acts], and other applicable local laws regulating the conduct of public meetings, in order to maximize transparency and provide the public access to their meetings." Completely excluding the public from these meetings is improper and actionable, particularly given the current lack of emergency or threat to life.

Board Members took an oath of office to defend the Constitutions of the United States and California, which includes every individual's right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness (including property). In founding principle of our nation's birth it is stated that the *sole* purpose of civil government and local, state and federal elected servants to protect individual God-given rights. (See United States Codes, Organic Laws of the United States: Preamble to

the Declaration of Independence; U. S. Constitution Fifth Amendment; California Constitution, Article 1.)

The initial Proclamation of “extreme peril” to life no longer holds true, claims of “menace” and “protection of life” from COVID-19 is not necessary, public meetings should be resumed and the County Health Officer should be directed to provide factual scientifically verifiable information to present to the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services and terminate the emergency from the state’s perspective in Nevada County, so that this Board and local City Councils answerable to local residents can again conduct business as usual pursuant to their oaths of office.

In conclusion, the proposed Emergency Ordinance is not legally sound, a continued emergency in Nevada County is scientifically baseless and tabling, deferring a vote or other otherwise by the Board is prudent. Further direction must be obtained from County Counsel and the local health officer. I look forward to assisting as appropriate regarding the legal issues identified herein. We all have the same goal: To mutually benefit all Nevada County citizens and businesses, including keeping county government fiscally responsible, viable and avoiding the perilous situation of litigation, which would be a further unnecessary drain upon county resources.

Dear Supervisors Hall, Scofield, Miller, Hoek and Anderson,

I am writing this letter to strongly oppose Item 26, the temporary Urgency Ordinance related to enforcement of COVID-related irregularities.

Prior to aggressively enforcing far-reaching guidelines such as the wearing of face masks in public, a risk benefit analysis should be performed. This is what is done in medicine when we obtain informed consent from our patients for various medical procedures. To date I have not seen any type of comprehensive risk benefit analysis to support the aggressive guidelines regarding the wearing of face coverings in public.

Regarding the wearing of face masks to mitigate the spread of SARS-CoV-2 we need further discussion regarding the wearing of masks by symptomatic versus asymptomatic individuals. A study by Leung et al published in Nature Medicine in May 2020 found that, "surgical face masks **could** prevent transmission of human coronaviruses and influenza viruses from **SYMPTOMATIC** individuals." Another study published in Respiratory Medicine this month (Aug 2020, Gao et al) found no SARS-CoV-2 infections in the 455 people who had contact with asymptomatic carriers. The authors concluded that the "infectivity of some asymptomatic SARS-CoV-2 carriers might be weak" and that the "results of the study may alleviate parts of the concern about asymptomatic infected people."

There is significant evidence that low grade hypoxia (too little oxygen), low grade hypercapnia (too much CO₂), increased resistance upon inhalation (more work for the diaphragm when breathing in) are known stresses to the body caused by face mask wearing especially by prolonged wearing of face masks. A study by Brewer et al published in Toxins in 2014 presents a heretofore unappreciated risk of rebreathing exhaled air. Brewer et al found that a subset of chronically ill patients had mold colonizing their sinuses. They found that in chronically ill patients this mold was frequently producing extremely dangerous mycotoxins. Wearing a mask would be extremely deleterious to the health of these individuals as it would cause them to rebreathe these extremely toxic mycotoxins. Mask wearing is also deleterious to the health of individuals with a variety of other chronic illnesses such as COPD, CHF, cancer and severe anxiety.

We need to more thoroughly evaluate the risks and benefits of wearing masks before burdensome fines are imposed for not complying with the governor's guidelines.

Thank you for looking at the big picture regarding widespread punitive fines for our local businesses. At present many local businesses are afraid of punishment of some sort if they honor patients' medical conditions that would make it harmful to their health to wear masks.

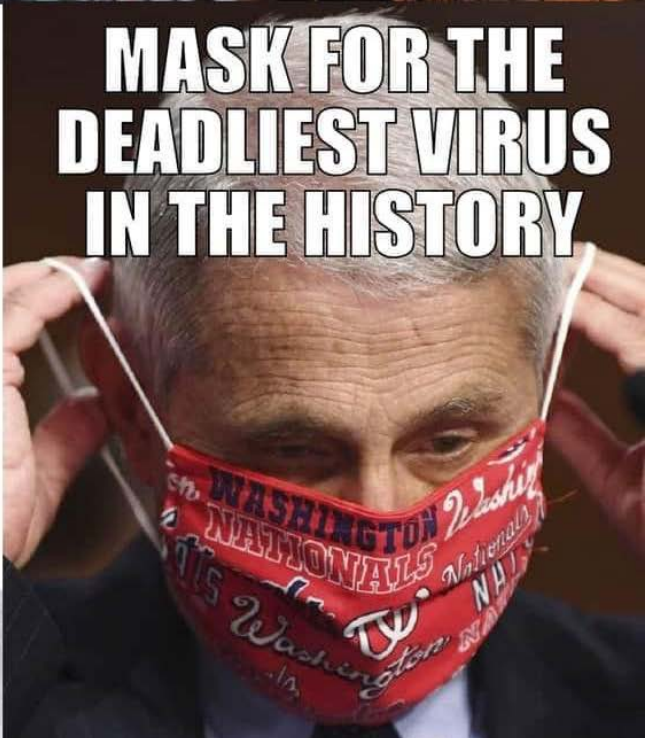
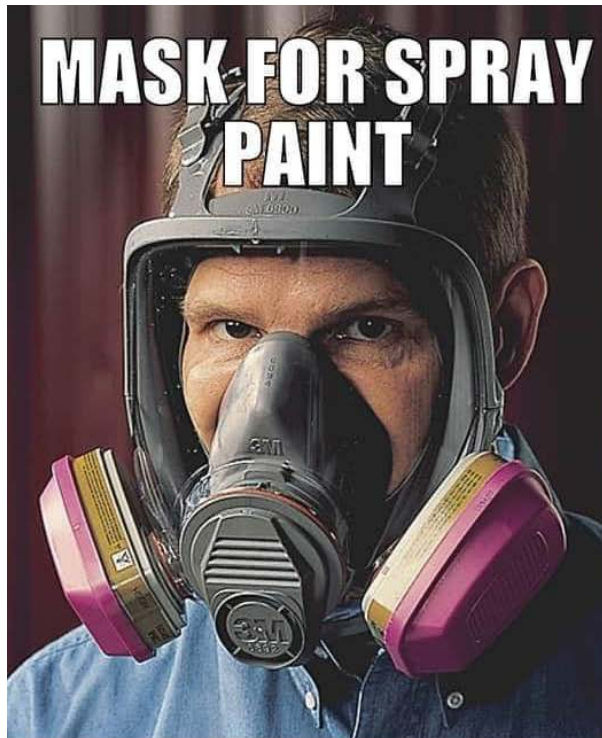

As well as the below points that I strongly urge you to look at and consider, please keep in mind the physical/mental health issues that prevent some people from wearing mask's in the first place.

Then, rains and cold weather will curtail business to a trickle, so by October ALL restaurants will be out of business. Take-out cannot sustain a restaurant at a profit in most cases. So, a business must choose whether to go bankrupt because their business is shuttered by the government or to go bankrupt for trying to perform their normal business. Like telling someone they are sentenced to die—here is a gun. You can kill yourself or we will do it. Don't tell me that is not draconian!

<!--[if !supportLists]-->2. <!--[endif]-->The ordinance turns business owners into police by placing the burden on them to assure customers follow mask and other COVID-19 orders.

<!--[if !supportLists]-->3. <!--[endif]-->Dining-in penalized. On what basis is there a distinction between being a customer in a restaurant and a customer in any business? Why is it ok for a customer to enter a grocery store, a pharmacy, a dry cleaner, a smoke shop, a liquor store, or any other business but not enter a restaurant? In any business, social distancing rules are in effect. The only answer is that one cannot wear a mask while eating or drinking, even if safely spaced from other diners. There are two factors here: fresh air flow and masking.

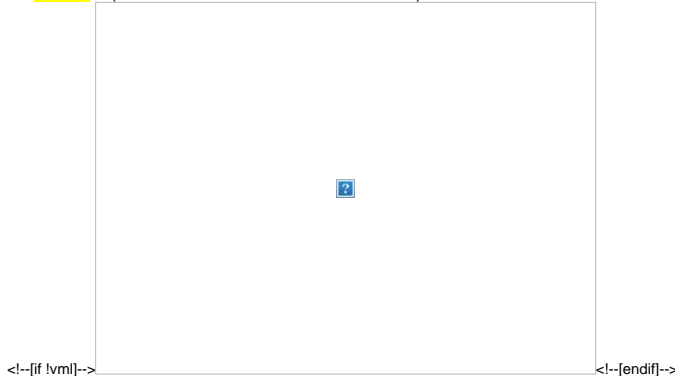

But some of our restaurants have installed higher rates of fresh air intake and advanced filtration systems into their HVAC systems. Similar as on airplanes. Yet, the one size fits all "COVID-19 Orders" do not recognize these fresh air and filtration measures and refuse to allow dining-in.

These masks cannot stop a virus as their particle size are small enough to fit through the holes in the fabric or simply escape via the open edges of such loosely-worn masks. So, most of this draconian enforcement is based on invalid science. Here are the facts:

51.7.

(a) This section shall be known and may be cited, as the Ralph Civil Rights Act of 1976.

(b) **All persons within the jurisdiction of this state have the right to be free from any violence, or intimidation by threat of violence, committed against their persons or property because of political affiliation,** or on account of any characteristic listed or defined in subdivision (b) or (e) of Section 51, or position in a labor dispute, or because another person perceives them to have one or more of those characteristics. The identification in this subdivision of particular bases of discrimination is illustrative rather than restrictive.

(c)

(1) A person shall not require another person to waive any legal right, penalty, remedy, forum, or procedure for a violation of this section, as a condition of entering into a contract for goods or services, including the right to file and pursue a civil action or complaint with, or otherwise notified, the Attorney General or any other public prosecutor, or law enforcement agency, the Department of Fair Employment and Housing, or any court or other governmental entity.

(2) A person shall not refuse to enter into a contract with **or refuse to provide goods or services to, another person on the basis that the other person refuses to waive any legal right, penalty, remedy, forum,** or procedure for a violation of this section, including the right to file and pursue a civil action or complaint with, or otherwise notify, the Attorney General or any other public prosecutor, or law enforcement agency, the Department of Fair Employment and Housing, or any other governmental entity.

(3) Any waiver of any legal right, penalty, remedy, forum, or procedure for a violation of this section, including the right to file and pursue a civil action or complaint with, or otherwise notify, the Attorney General or any other public prosecutor, or law enforcement agency, the Department of Fair Employment and Housing, or any other governmental entity shall be knowing and voluntary, in writing, and expressly not made as a condition of entering into a contract for goods or services or as a condition of providing or receiving goods and services.

(4) **Any waiver of any legal right, penalty, remedy, forum, or procedure for a violation of this section that is required as a condition of entering into a contract for goods or services shall be deemed involuntary, unconscionable, against public policy, and unenforceable.** Nothing in this subdivision shall affect the enforceability or validity of any other provision of the contract.

(5) Any person who seeks to enforce a waiver of any legal right, penalty, remedy, forum, or procedure for a violation of this section shall have the burden of proving that the waiver was knowing and voluntary and not made as a condition of the contract or of providing or receiving the goods or services.

The following are my public comments for the Nevada County Board of Supervisors meeting tomorrow which I am submitting by this email. They concern the pending legislation increasing penalties on non-compliant business violating health mandates, a measure which I strongly support. I have been a resident of the county for 20 years. I have also been an attorney for over 45 years in six states and have litigated matters of constitutional rights both for and against government entities and individuals. I am not a fake constitutional lawyer as I fear others who may have influenced local establishments to not comply with health regulations might be.

First, I urge you not be intimidated by opposition to such legislation. Cautious and reasonable people in this pandemic understand it is not prudent to personally gather in large groups amongst shouting maskless protesters. Sometimes it has to be done, but it's a risky proposition and many will not do it. Of course, those that ignore science are more than willing to be in your face. However if you look at social media you will see 85% of the people are with you.

Secondly, don't be confused by generic statements about "constitutional rights." "Constitutional rights" do not derive from wishful thinking. Asserting a "Constitutional right," to eat chicken piccata inside, doesn't create one. The United States Supreme noted this year in a case challenging Gov. Newsom's restrictions that: "Our Constitution principally entrusts the safety and the health of the people to the politically accountable officials of the States ... When those officials undertake to act in areas fraught with medical and scientific uncertainties, their latitude must be especially broad..." (quotes omitted). So, under the Constitution it is "politically accountable officials" who have the right with "especially broad latitude" to make the call on safety precautions. It's not Sergio, nor Friar Tucks. IT'S YOU! That IS the Constitutional.

For this reason this matter involves no "Freedoms" we so-called "Angels" need protect. Restaurants have no more "freedom" to operate a room where virus is potentially in the air, than a room with cigarette smoke in it. This is not merely a matter of people freely choosing their own risks. Illegal indoor diners imperil more than themselves. Now is the moment.
