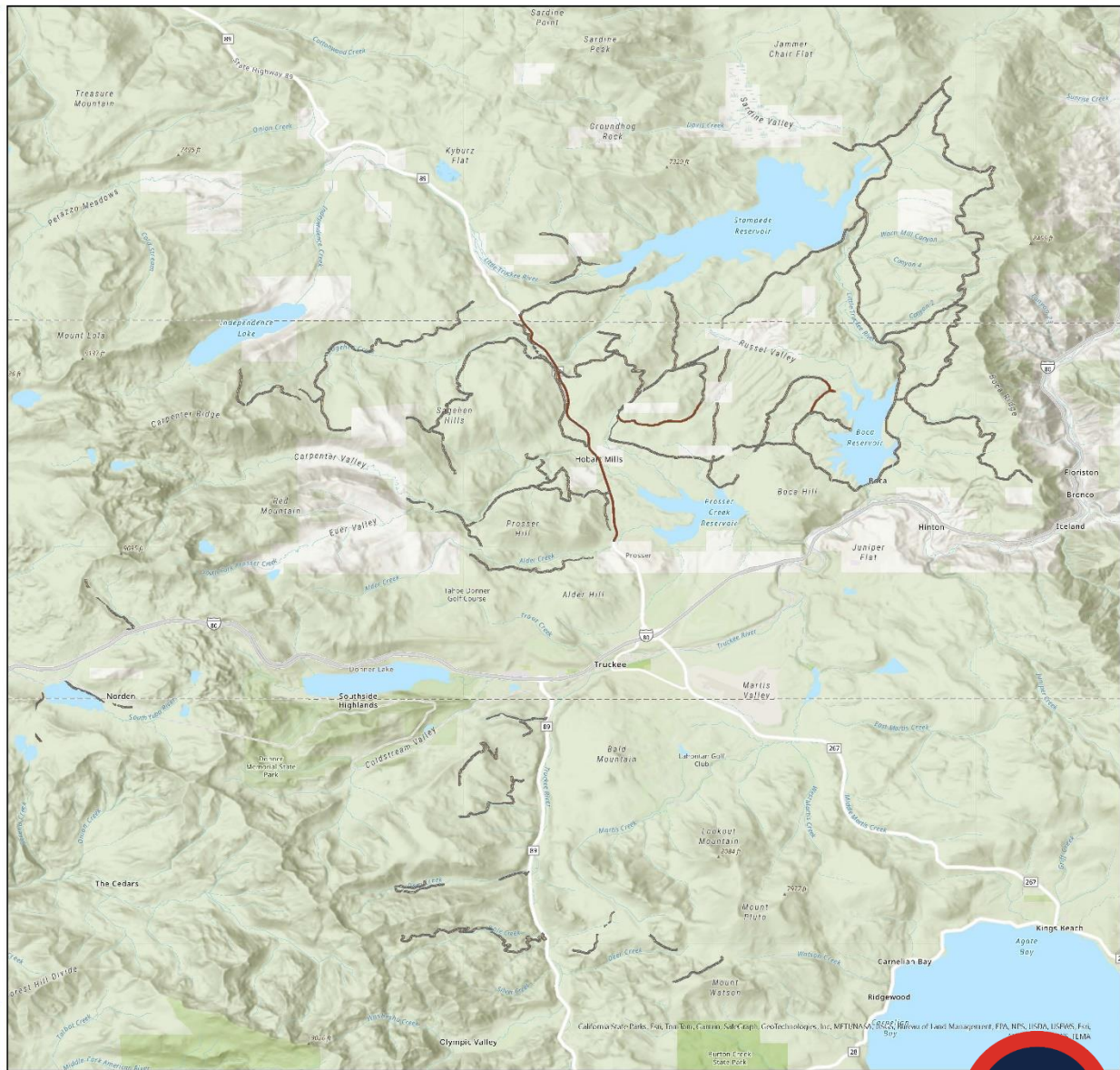

Recommendation

Approve resolution for the Good Neighbor Agreement (GNA) between the USDA Forest Service, Tahoe National Forest and the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services for the Wildfire Resilient Communities and Landscapes Collaboration in the amount of \$301,000.00 with \$35,657.24 in USFS in-kind and \$10,107.92 in OES in-kind for the period July 9, 2024 through December 31, 2033, authorizing the Director of Emergency Services to execute the agreement and directs the Auditor Controller to amend the Fiscal Year 2024/25 Emergency Services Budget.
