Daniel B. Landon

The County of Nevada Board of Supervisors, City of Grass Valley City Council, Nevada City City Council and the Town of Truckee Town Council takes great pleasure in recognizing Nevada County Transportation Commission Executive Director Daniel B. Landon for over 30 years of dedicated public service.

Dan has served as Executive Director to the Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) since June 1990 and is retiring after more than 30 years of dedication and excellence, while also serving as the Executive Director of the Nevada County Airport Land Use Commission and the Truckee Tahoe Airport Land Use Commission since May 2010. Prior to joining NCTC, he also worked in Glenn and Butte Counties in various transportation planning roles, which included transportation planning, transit operations and management for a career in public service that spans 36 years.

Throughout his tenure, Dan has served on numerous statewide and federal committees representing both the interests of the unincorporated areas of the county and the incorporated jurisdictions alike, while serving as a champion for all of California's rural counties. He has served on statewide committees, including the California Transportation Directions 2010, California Transportation Plan, California Rural Counties Task Force (serving as Chair in 1994 and 1995), and the Transportation Development Act Review Committee. In 1995, at the request of the Federal Highway Administration he participated in evaluation of the proposed national Intelligent Transportation Systems architecture. Dan also participated in the North State Super Region, established in 2010, which represents a partnership between the fourteen northern California Regional Transportation Planning Agencies and two northern California Metropolitan Planning Organizations. In 1999, Mr. Landon received a California Transportation Foundation Transportation Award recognizing his accomplishments in transportation planning and programming.

Dan Landon's career is exemplified by his professionalism and ability to build partnerships and consensus on transportation projects that have improved safety, operations, and the quality of life for all the citizens of Nevada County, City of Grass Valley, Town of Truckee, and Nevada City. Locally, he facilitated the development of a Regional Transportation Mitigation Fee Program for western Nevada County that was adopted in 2001. As of June 30, 2020, the Regional Transportation Mitigation Fee Program had collected more than \$6,940,595 for transportation improvements. Mr. Landon has established a strong partnership with Caltrans District 3 to secure funding for many projects across all local jurisdictions, including the widening project on State Route 49 from the Bear River to the Wolf-Combie Road intersection, State Route 49/La Barr Meadows Road signalization and widening project, State Route 267 Truckee Bypass, Dorsey Drive Interchange, and State Route 89 pedestrian tunnel. Most recently, he has led efforts on developing preliminary design and environmental documentation for the State Route 49 Corridor Improvement Project, which will lead to construction of the next phases of improvements.

Time and time again, he participated in bringing many transportation enhancement and multi-modal projects to fruition, including construction of the Nevada County Narrow Gauge Railroad Museum, Gold Country Stage Trolley Street Transfer Facility, SR 49 Nevada County Gateway Monument, and multiple pedestrian and bicycle improvements. Mr. Landon has truly made a lasting impact on transportation improvements, public safety and contributed to the increase of quality of life in our region and state. His integrity and passion for excellence has been an invaluable resource in the ongoing work of the Nevada County Transportation Commission.

Therefore, the County of Nevada Board of Supervisors, City of Grass Valley City Council, Nevada City City Council and the Town of Truckee Town Council take great pleasure in congratulating and recognizing Nevada County Transportation Commission Executive Director Daniel B.
