RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES GRANT AWARD XC21040290 FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY VICTIM SERVICES PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$144,651.00 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2022 TO DECEMBER 31, 2022 AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND ALL ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS TO FULFILL THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) has awarded the County of Nevada District Attorney's Office State Victim of Crimes General Funds (VCGF) and Federal Victim of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cal OES grant award is comprised of State VCGF funds in the amount of \$51,288.00 and Federal VOCA funds in the amount of \$93,363.00.00, and have been made available for the grant period of January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to provide services to victims and witnesses of crime as specified in California Penal Code sections 13835-13835.5, including crisis intervention and other comprehensive services for the victims and witnesses of crime in Nevada County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby accepts the California Office of Emergency Services grant for the Nevada County Victim Services Program in the amount of \$144,651.00, for the grant period of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney, or their designee, is authorized to execute any additional documents, including extensions or amendments thereto, required by Cal OES and necessary for implementation of this grant award.
