SUBJECT: Resolution approving Amendment #1 to the Contract with Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing, Inc., dba AMI Housing, Inc., for the provision of Housing Support to maintain the maximum contract price of \$714,473, revise Exhibit "A", Schedule of Services to reflect the removal of case management services and maintain the housing navigation services and revise Exhibit "B", Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the changes to the Housing and Staffing Line Items for the maximum contract price for the term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. (RES 22-314)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Contract services are funded through available CalWORKs Single Allocation, and CalWORKs Housing Support Program monies that may be used to support opportunities/services to assist low income residents in overcoming barriers to employment and to assist CalWORKs participants in becoming financially self-sufficient. Services are within the Department's FY 2022/2023 budget and there are no County general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: On June 28, 2022, per Resolution 22-314 the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with AMI Housing to provide housing services and support for CalWORKs participant families. This amendment will reflect the removal of case management services such as preparing budgets, plans, preparation of paperwork, supportive counseling, resolving past legal or credit issues, providing referrals to services as needed, and credit and budget counseling. Nevada County will contract with Connecting Point to provide these case management services. Contractor will continue to support CalWORKs families to find and maintain safe, stable, permanent housing. Services will include housing search and placement, landlord engagement, direct payments for rent, and master leasing for units that are suitable for our CalWORKs families.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment.
