SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Submittal of Applications for Calrecycle Payment

Programs

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the attached Resolution authorizing submittal of applications for all Calrecycle payment programs for which Nevada County is eligible.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Calrecycle payment programs are State funded and support recycling and diversion programs. Funding will affect the Solid Waste Western Budget. A budget amendment is not needed and there will be no impact to the County General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has established various payment programs to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions, and in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the payment programs. CalRecycle's procedures for administering payment programs require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the payment program.

This resolution would authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works, or her designee, to apply for and administer Calrecycle payment programs which the County is eligible. Examples of available payment programs through Calrecycle include the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program and the Used Oil Payment Program. This funding would be used to enhance existing programs.
